## An Episcopal Church

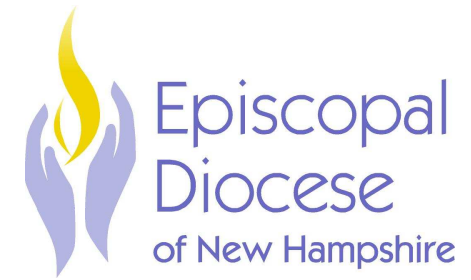
