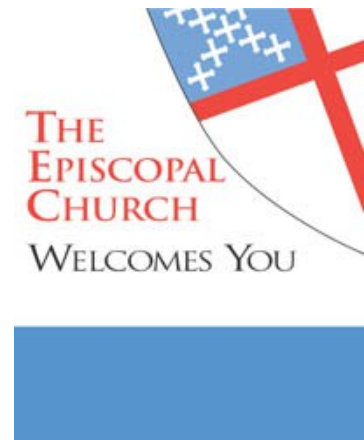
❖ Transfiguration provides space for community groups including AA, Narcotics Anonymous, Community Alliance for Teen Safety and Success by 6.

Annual Events

- **Free monthly *Elijah's Table* Community Suppers** are held on the 2nd Sunday of each month at the church and the 3rd Sunday of each month at the synagogue from 5:00-6:30 P.M.
- **Awesome Mountain Camp** for kids ages 4-11 is the first full week of August each year. This is a half-day camp that begins with breakfast and ends with a snack. (There is a small fee to cover our expenses.)
- An **Interfaith Thanksgiving Service**, sponsored by Transfiguration and Etz Hayim Synagogue, is the Tuesday before Thanksgiving Day at 7:15 P.M.
- Our **St. Nicholas Fair** with crafts, vendors, and homemade lunch is the Saturday before Thanksgiving.
